

BONE MINERAL DENSITOMETRY

BMD uses x-rays to image your spine and hip to determine bone mass.

BMD exams are offered at our Red Deer location.

BMD is covered by Alberta Health Care Referrals are necessary for all bookings

Exam Duration: 15min

PATIENT PREPARATION

- **Do not** take calcium or vitamin supplements the day of the exam.
- You cannot have had an x-ray procedure using barium or dye in the 7 days leading up to your exam.
- You cannot have a BMD if you are under 18 or are pregnant.

- Wear loose fitting clothing, with no metal (including underwire) or you may be asked to change into a gown.
- × Fasting is not required.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR EXAM:

- When you arrive, you will be asked to fill out a short questionnaire.
- Your height and weight will be taken.

- The technologist will explain the exam, and have you lie on your back on the table.
- You will be required to hold very still during the exam.

AFTER YOUR EXAM:

After a BMD you will be free to go.

Your doctor can be contacted after **1 week**, for the results.

CAMIS strives to have the results sent to your referring doctor **within 24 hours**. Sometimes exams require consultation which can delay reporting. If your doctor has **not received results in 7 days**, please email **connect@camiscare.ca** with the concern and include your Alberta Health Care number. An administrator will determine the cause of the delay and respond to you.
