MRI uses magnetic fields to obtain high resolution, three-dimensional images of any area of the body.

Referrals are necessary for all bookings

Exam Duration: 15 - 45mins

PATIENT PREPARATION

- You can not have an MRI if you have a pacemaker or certain surgically implanted devices.
- Our MRI booking specialist will review an MRI safety screening form with you.
- Inform our MRI booking specialist if there is a chance of pregnancy.
- Take all medications as necessary.

- **4 hour fasting** is required for all abdominal and pelvic studies.
- Wear loose comfortable clothing with no metal or zippers.
- You may be asked to change into a gown.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR EXAM:

- The technologist will review the MRI safety screening form prior to entering the scan room.
- Depending on the type of exam, you may need an intravenous line started for injection of contrast media.
- After you are positioned on the table you will be given a headset to both listen to music and communicate with the technologist.
- You will be required to **hold very still** during the exam.
- There will be loud "banging" sounds as the images are obtained.
- You may feel warm during the procedure which is completely normal.

AFTER YOUR EXAM:

You will be free to go.
