X-rays are a common form of diagnostic imaging using a small amount of ionizing radiation to diagnose and monitor a variety of bone, chest, abdominal and soft tissue disorders.

Exam Duration: 10 - 15mins

PATIENT PREPARATION

- Appointments are not necessary; we offer a walk in service.
- Bring your requisition and health care card with you.
- Wear loose comfortable clothing, free of metal or zippers if possible.

WHAT TO EXPECT DURING YOUR EXAM:

- After you check in at the front desk you will be asked to have a seat in the waiting room.
- A technologist will call you in for your exam on a first come first served basis.
- You may be asked to change into a gown and remove jewelry, depending on what kind of exam you are having.
- If you are **female** and between the **ages of 9 and 55** you will be asked about your menstrual status and the possibility of pregnancy. You may be asked to sign a pregnancy waiver.
- The technologist will position you for your exam and take the x-rays.

AFTER YOUR EXAM:

You will be free to go.

CAMIS strives to have the results sent to your referring doctor **within 24 hours**. Sometimes exams require consultation which can delay reporting. If your doctor has **not received results in 7 days**, please email **connect@camiscare.ca** with the concern and include your Alberta Health Care number. An administrator will determine the cause of the delay and respond to you.
